**Check-In & Check-Out:** Check-in for day camp is at 7:30 a.m. We will have staff available to greet you and check your child in. A Pick-Up Authorization Form must be filled out when you drop your child off. **Only authorized persons listed on this form are allowed to pick up your child from day camp.** Authorized persons will need to sign in and sign out your child each day. Please be prepared to show identification at check-out each day. Check-out is at 4:00 p.m. Check-in and check-out is at the same time Monday through Friday.

**Balance Due:** Any balance due on your camp session is due at check-in on the first day of your camp. If you wish, you may pay the full amount before your arrival or you may send in partial payments ahead of time – please be sure your camper’s name is in the memo line of your check.

**Participation Releases/Health History/Medical Consent Form:** The Health and Release Form can also be downloaded from our website. We prefer this form not be completed more than one month prior to the camp visit so that we have the most current information. It can be mailed in during the month prior to the start of your camp or it can be turned in at check in. If your child has a health issue we should be aware of before he or she comes to camp, please contact us. This entire form must be fully completed, with required signatures.

**Medications:** Please bring all medications (prescriptions and/or over the counter) in their original containers, clearly labeled with the campers name, and accompanied by clear instructions. All medications will be stored and be disbursed as required.

**Summer Mission Project 2018:** Our summer mission project is “Shoes for the Mission”. Lutheran Island Camp will be gathering any and ALL types of shoes including sneakers, work boots, dress shoes, and heels. Camp will receive a small compensation for the shoes we gather. The shoes will be reconditioned, then packed in shipping containers and sent to third world countries. So when you come to camp bring along those shoes that are too small, out of style, or just not used anymore!
