



Island Day Camp and Ranch Day Camp Information Letter

Faith

By Faith is the 2018 theme. We will be using Hebrews 11:1 for our Bible study, devotions and some activities. “Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.” All of our programs and resources are provided from a Lutheran perspective. We welcome all children and expect them to participate in all activities, including Bible study, devotions, meal time prayers, and cabin activities. We are a Christian camp and expect that each of our campers, volunteers, and staff will treat each other with respect and in a Christ like manner.

Check-In & Pick-Up: Registration/check-in for day camp is at 8:00 a.m. at **Lutheran Island Camp** for **BOTH** Island Day Camp and Ranch Day Camp. We will have staff available to greet you and check your child in. A Pick Up Authorization Form must be filled out when you drop your child off. Only authorized people listed on this form are allowed to pick up your child from day camp. Please be prepared to show identification at pick-up each day. Pick-up is at 4:00 p.m. Check-in and pick-up is at the same time Monday through Friday. **If bussing is offered and you choose to have your child ride the camp bus, check-in and pick-up will be similar.** Again, a Pick Up Authorization Form must be filled out on the first day, and only authorized people listed on this form are allowed to pick up your child from the camp bus.

Balance Due: Any balance due on your camp session is due at check-in on the first day of your camp. If you wish, you may pay the full amount before your arrival or you may send in partial payments ahead of time – please be sure your camper’s name is in the memo line of your check.

Participation Releases/Health History/Medical Consent Form: If you did not fill out a health and release form as part of your registration form, please bring the completed health and release form with you on the first day of your camp session or mail it in ahead of time. If your child has a health issue we should be aware of before he or she comes to camp, please contact us. This entire form must be fully completed, with required signatures.

Medications: Please bring all medications (prescriptions and/or over the counter) in their original containers, clearly labeled with the campers name, and accompanied by clear instructions. All medications will be stored and be disbursed as required.

Canteen Money: Money for the camp store, “The Canteen”, is optional. We recommend that you send around \$10.00 for snacks for the week per child. Candy, snacks, and drinks are up to \$1.00 each. If you would like your child to be able to purchase a shirt or souvenir, clothing in the camp store is priced from \$10.00 to \$30.00 and souvenirs are between \$1.00 for a bracelet and up to \$15.00 for a plush, stuffed animal – camp staff can assist your child in purchasing these items. Candy, pop, shirts and other items may be purchased when the Canteen is open.

Summer Mission Project 2018: Our summer mission project is “Shoes for the Mission”. Lutheran Island Camp will be gathering any and ALL types of shoes including sneakers, work boots, dress shoes, and heels. Camp will receive a small compensation for the shoes we gather. The shoes will be reconditioned, then packed in shipping containers and sent to third world countries. So when you come to camp bring along those shoes that are too small, out of style, or just not used anymore!
