Frequently Asked Questions

1. Do we need any special equipment to participate in paintball camp?

No you do not! We will provide everything: paint, CO2, markers, helmets, and cleaning supplies. It is suggested you have long pants and a long sleeve shirt to wear while playing.

2. Can I bring my own equipment?

You definitely can bring your own equipment if you have it. Note that if your marker outclasses our standard ones too much we may ask you to use our equipment for some games just to keep things fair, but we promise to let you go all out for at least a little bit!

3. If my child has a friend coming along, will they get to stay with them?

When you register your child there should be an option to put down cabin mates, make sure to put your camper's friends down under that and we will make sure they will be together!

4. Does paintball paint stain clothing?

The paintballs we use are biodegradable and come out completely in a normal wash cycle.

5. Is there a chance of serious injury?

No more than any other activity where you are running! Player safety is the top priority, and everyone is required to wear helmets when games are live whether or not they are participating. When hit, players do sometimes have small bruises or "souvenirs" develop, but these heal quickly and do no lasting damage. Players who wear extra padding (which could mean no more than a sweatshirt) can often avoid bruises entirely.
