Be sure to put Saturday, August 3rd on your calendar. It will be the 28th Annual Quilt Auction in support of the work of Lutheran Island Camp – our camp. There will be over 300 quilts, lap quilts, baby quilts and silent auction items available. Many of them are already available to bid on or purchase at the camp's website, www.islandcamp.org. The Quilt Auction has been providing \$30,000 and more each year (last year over \$41,000) to help with camperships for children and families, purchase new equipment, and otherwise support this great ministry. Quilt prices will range from \$25 on up to nearly \$1000 for a few of the large, machine quilted quilts. There are quilts for every taste including children's quilts with sports themes, beautiful baby quilts, denim quilts, and large queen and king sized quilts. There are also some beautiful banner quilts that are actually works of art.

This year Lutheran Island Camp will be celebrating the 100th birthday of one of our original volunteers, Virginia Ansonge. Each year Virginia does another quilt and this year is no exception. However this year, people from around the country are buying a share in her quilt. The shares require a \$100 donation which will be matched dollar for dollar by a generous donor up to \$20,000.
